Exhibit Rules and Regulations:

Arrangement of exhibits: Exhibits shall be so arranged as not to obstruct the general view nor hide the exhibits of others. No exhibits will be permitted that interfere with the use of other exhibits or impede access to them for free use of aisles.

KAMSA will provide: security, cleaning, company listing on website and program. KAMSA will provide one 6 foot table and chair for each vendor.

Backwalls may not exceed over 8 foot in height. Please make sure you let us know if you are setting up a back wall as we can plan appropriately.

Double-end booths are not allowed at KAMSA. If you need more space you may be able to rent multiple booths in the same row.

No signs are to be above 8 feet.

There is no subletting of space at KAMSA.

Moving pictures, sound devices and lighting may not interfere with other exhibitors, and shall be operated at a level to conform to the Exhibit managers' requirements. The Exhibit manager will have final say on any vendor complaints.

If you need power at your booth, please let us know on the vendor registration application.

Nothing may be glued, tacked, nailed or permanently attached to columns, walls or other parts of the building.

Exhibitor assumes all responsibility for compliance with all city and state ordinances and regulations including those covering fire, safety and health. All exhibit materials must be located within the booth and be protected by safety guards and devices where necessary.

Electrical wiring must conform with all local and state government requirements.

No flammable liquids are allowed in the building.

Smoking is strictly prohibited on the property, inside or outside of the building.

No heater, barbecue or heat producing devices, open flame or torches are allowed at the KAMSA Conference Vendor area.

KAMSA requires that an exhibitor not discriminate in its exhibit, in materials distributed, displayed or sold, or in any other manner against any person based upon race, religion, color, creed, sex, national origin, socio-economic status, ancestry, marital status, sexual preference, age, handicap, or disability. KAMSA reserves the right to decline or terminate an exhibitor in non-compliance.

Exhibitor assumes the entire responsibility and liability of loss, damage, and claims arising out of injury, loss or damage that may occur to the Exhibitor's agents, employees or invitees, or arising out of damage to the Exhibitor's displays, equipment, and other property brought upon the premises, and Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Exhibit Manager and the conference site, their agents and employees from any and all such loss, damage, and claims arising out of, in, at, or in connection with the Exhibitor's display.

No exhibitor will be allowed to enter the vendor area for set up unless the vendor registration is complete and fully paid.

If an Exhibitor pays for a booth and cancels only 50% of the money paid will be returned.

Exhibit Manager shall have the power to interpret or amend these rules and regulations. Exhibitor agrees to abide by reasonable rules and regulations that may hereafter be adopted by Exhibit Manager which shall be as much a part hereof as though fully incorporated herein.

KAMSA Exhibit Manager reserves the right to reject any application or to cancel rental or display space to any person or company whose display or conduct, is in the opinion of KAMSA, incompatible with the general character or objective of the exhibition. Exhibit Manager may restrict, prohibit or evict any Exhibitor who does not comply with the rules and regulations.

KAMSA is not responsible for the theft of any items from the Exhibitors booth or fire that may damage the booth. Exhibitors agrees to protect, save and hold harmless KAMSA, conference site owners and all agents and employees thereof forever harmless for any damages or charges imposed for the violations of any law or ordinance, whether occasioned by the negligence of the exhibitor or those holding under the exhibitor.
